YEARLY AWARDS

1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Year Achievement Awards - These Awards give Host Trainers the opportunity to nominate an Apprentice they believe to be the most outstanding in their year.

TRADE ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Carpentry & Joinery and Bricklaying - These Awards give Host Trainers the opportunity to nominate Apprentices they believe have achieved outstanding performance on the job.

OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY AWARD

These Awards give Host Trainers the opportunity to nominate Apprentices who obtain high standards of Occupational Health & Safety.

OTHER CATEGORIES

The following categories will be judged by HIA, they do not require nomination by Host Trainers.
