HIA Scholarship Terms and Conditions

An applicant must have read and agreed to the terms and conditions set out below in order to submit a request for nomination and accept a HIA Training Scholarship.

I agree that:

1. The information on the nomination form is complete and accurate. Falsification of any information may cause disqualification from the scholarship program.
2. It is the applicant's responsibility to make sure the nomination form is complete by the required deadline. If not, the nomination may be disqualified from the scholarship program for that designated deadline and may be transferred to the next program deadline.
3. The nomination form, upon receipt, becomes the property of the Housing Industry Association (HIA).
4. HIA and its Partners may distribute promotional material and industry information to the scholarship nominee. The nominee may advise at any time for his/her contact details to be removed from HIA's mailing list.
5. If selected as a scholarship award recipient, HIA and its associated Partners may use the nominee's name and photo/s of the scholarship recipient, in any marketing and promotional materials.
6. The Scholarship includes the cost of the selected HIA training course fees and any resources as advertised in the specified HIA Training course. Any other resources not included in the advertised training course fee will be at the recipient's expense.
7. The scholarship may only be used towards the cost of selected HIA Training course fees. It cannot be applied to training already completed or commenced by the recipient.
8. No part of a scholarship is refundable and cannot be transferred.
9. The scholarship will lapse in the event that training under scholarship has not commenced within 6 months from receipt of scholarship, pending availability and unless otherwise agreed in writing by HIA.
10. Training courses will be conducted at HIA premises or a location selected by HIA within the State and subject to the availability of courses and vacancies.
11. Nominees must be engaged in the building industry as an apprentice, employee or contractor at the time of nominating for a scholarship and at the time of commencing the scholarship training.
12. Entry into some HIA training courses is subject to eligibility. Some eligibility requirements are established by government and their agencies. A scholarship recipient must meet the entry criteria for the selected HIA training course. It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to contact HIA Training Services for eligibility information about specific courses.
13. Nominees will be preferably, but not limited to, 25 years of age or younger at time of nomination.
14. HIA's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
15. If a nominee is unsuccessful in receiving a training scholarship for the nominated scholarship deadline, the nominee may reapply for future HIA training scholarships.
16. To ensure your training complies with the relevant licensing authorities and is current and up to date, it is highly recommended that your course be completed within 12 months. The scholarship will lapse in the event that training under the scholarship has not been completed within 18 months of commencement.
17. HIA reserves the right to change these terms & conditions from time to time.
