Input required for new national drafting qualification

The national Skills Council for the construction industry has appointed a consultant to develop a national qualification for drafting. This will, when completed, be the training course for all who train in this area and result in a national qualification.

Meetings were recently held with industry to discuss the required content for the course and those present completed the attached form.

The 'Tasks, Skills & Knowledge Checklist' (xxxx)for drafting is provided for those who could not attend the workshop but who may have an interest in providing input to the development process.

We trust the instrument is relatively self-explanatory to complete but it may be useful to note that:

- The Checklist is a means of gathering input about the work undertaken by different types of draftspeople across the nation. The Checklist also seeks input to help define the skills and knowledge that are needed to do the job well.

By collating diverse feedback we will be able to build a profile of the work undertaken by a range of draftspeople whether they work in small practices focussing on residential work or in larger firms operating across all parts of the construction industry.

To help us do this it is important to ensure Question 3, which seeks an explanation of the role undertaken by the draftperson, is completed.
